







End users of cultural activities are concentrated in Ramallah, Bethlehem and Jerusalem.




Culture gets Of the annual budget of the Palestinian Authority LOWEST IN THE REGION.




Biggest supporters of the sector on the local scene but there is little coordination amongst them.

Firms and banks play a major role in supporting cultural productions through financing important festivals and cultural activities.






86% of staff working at cultural centres lack media and communication skills

- Examples in Ramallah: Culture Palace.




